- Minors must be accompanied by a Parent or Legal Guardian.
- You will need to wear something short sleeved and comfortable for surgery. So please if you wear a sweater or sweatshirt into the office wear something under it.
- If you have a tongue, nose or lip piercing you will need to take it out prior to your surgery. You may bring it to the office and put it back in after surgery.
- No cell phones, cameras or recording devices in the surgical rooms.
